I am writing this letter after recently completing a new construction project with Fitzpatrick Architects as the firm leading the project and Brian Phillips as the project manager. My company added approximately 12,000 square feet of office space to an existing 4,000 square foot office. Brian and his team are extremely detailed, professional, and pay close attention to their clients' needs. As someone who also works in the construction business, I can tell you that Brian truly manages every aspect of the project.

When Brian and I first met to go over my requirements and desires for the project, I told him that I wanted an 'outdoorsy' feel as well as bringing in some elements of our construction business.
